

#### **BURKINA FASO**

For the first time since November 2020, the country office resumed distribution of mixed rations composed of in-kind and CBT to refugees in Goudébou camp

#### MALI

To respond to the socio-economic effects of COVID-19, WFP started a safety net intervention targeting 182,000 vulnerable and food insecure people.

#### **NIGER**

#### **EXPECTED PIPELINE BREAKS** (6-month shortfalls- US\$)








Net funding requirements (6 months needs-based- US\$)




## **AVERAGE MONTHLY REQUIREMENTS (US\$) - August**
