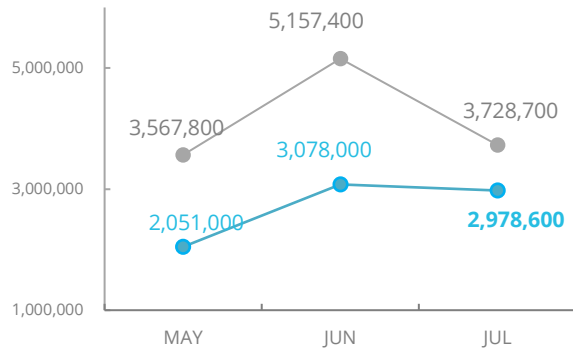

**OPERATIONAL UPDATES**

**BURKINA FASO**

For the first time since November 2020, the country office resumed distribution of mixed rations composed of in-kind and CBT to refugees in Goudébou camp.

**MALI**

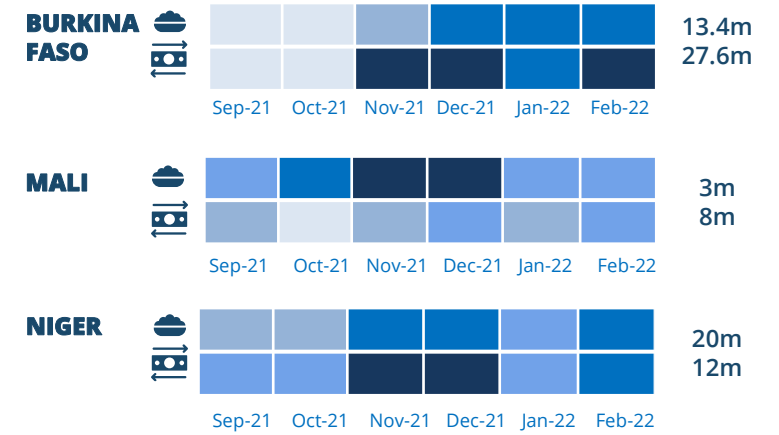
To respond to the socio-economic effects of COVID-19, WFP started a safety net intervention targeting 182,000 vulnerable and food insecure people.

**NIGER**

The end-line survey for the pastoral lean season response was carried out in July (following the baseline survey conducted in May). A sample of 200 beneficiary households were surveyed via telephone calls in Tillabéri, Tahoua, Maradi, and Zinder regions.

**EXPECTED PIPELINE BREAKS (6-month shortfalls- US\$)**



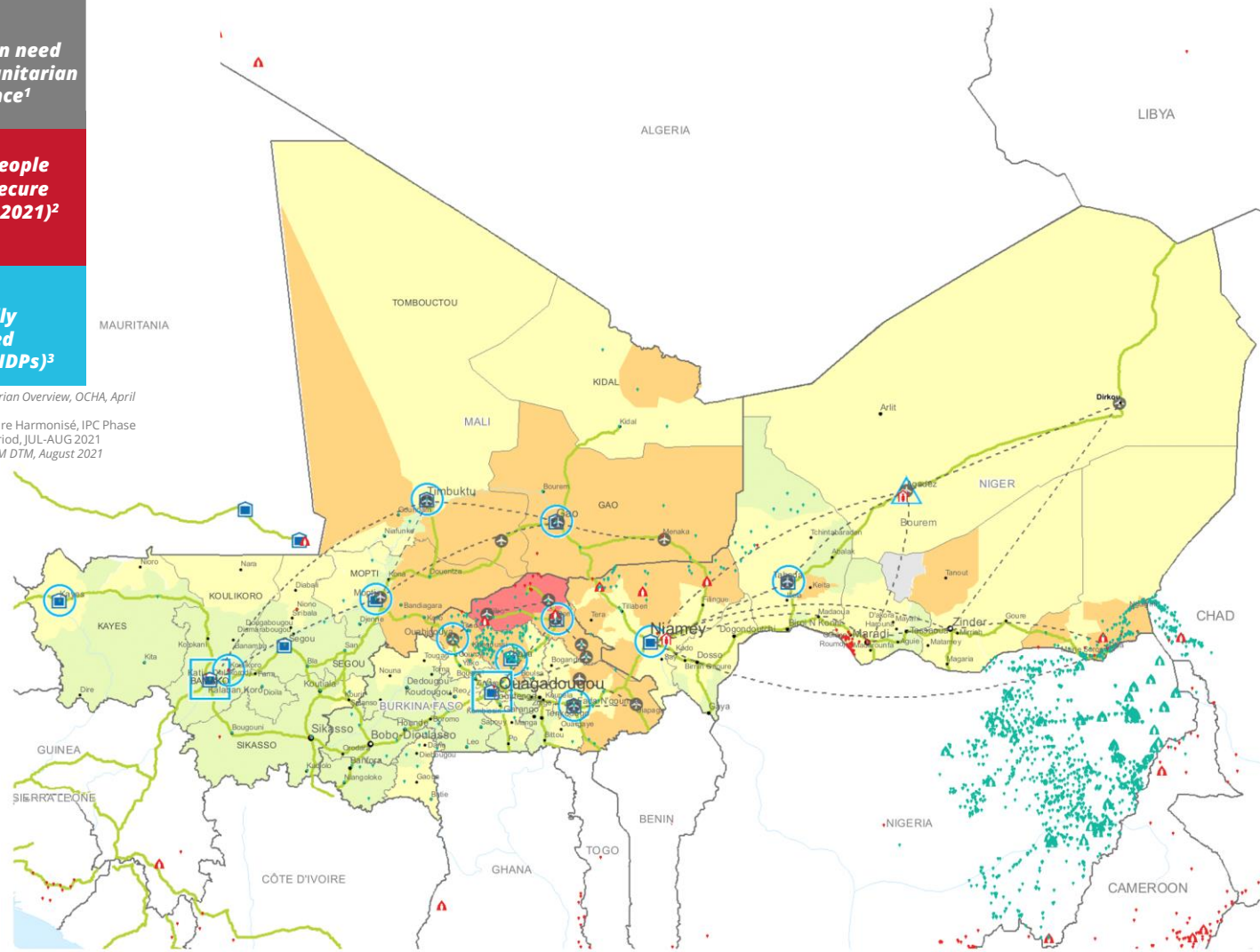

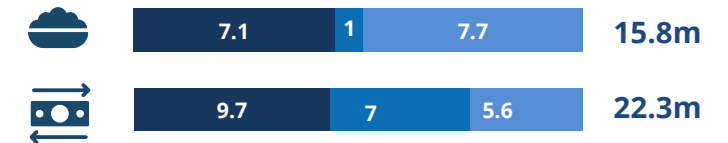
