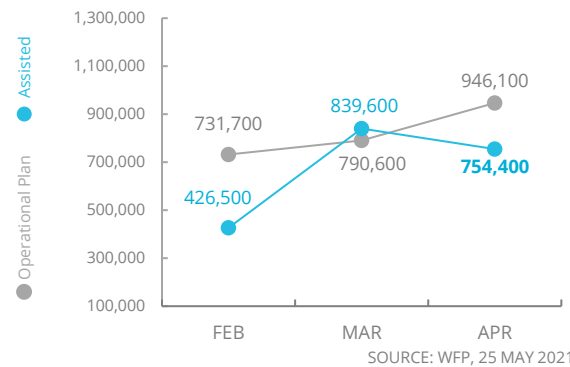

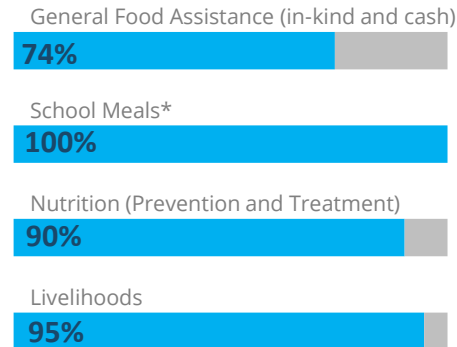

COVID-19 OPERATIONAL IMPACT

Assisted	Status	WFP Response
503,600	✓	GFD and Nutrition activities were affected by security constraints, lack of escorts in some areas and commodity shortfalls.
124,400	✓	WFP provided on-site school meals under only the home-grown school feeding programme. Emergency School Feeding activities could not take place because of the lack of food commodities.

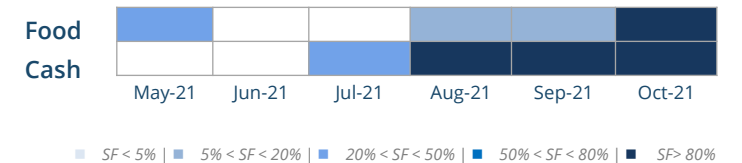

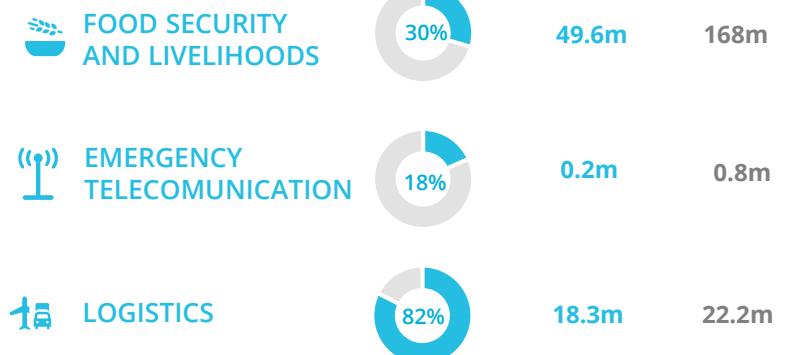

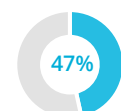
