



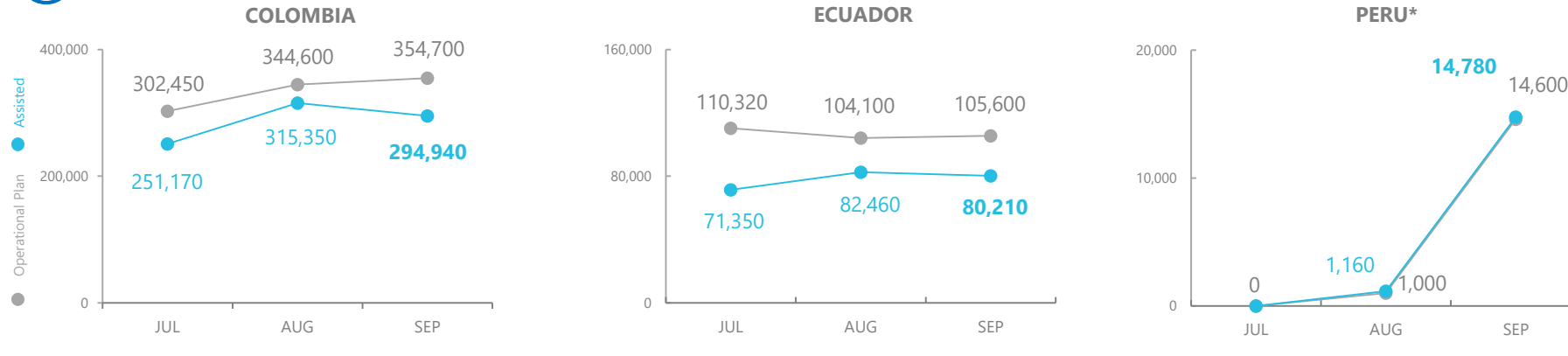

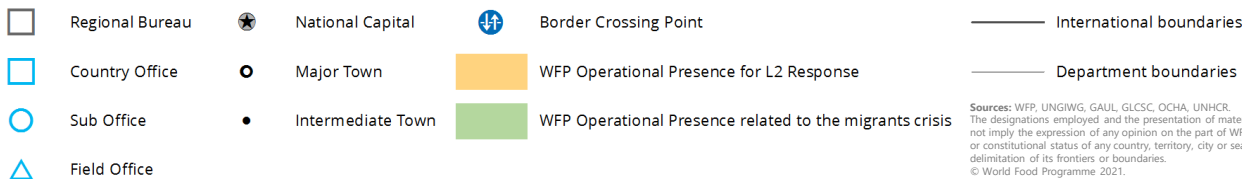
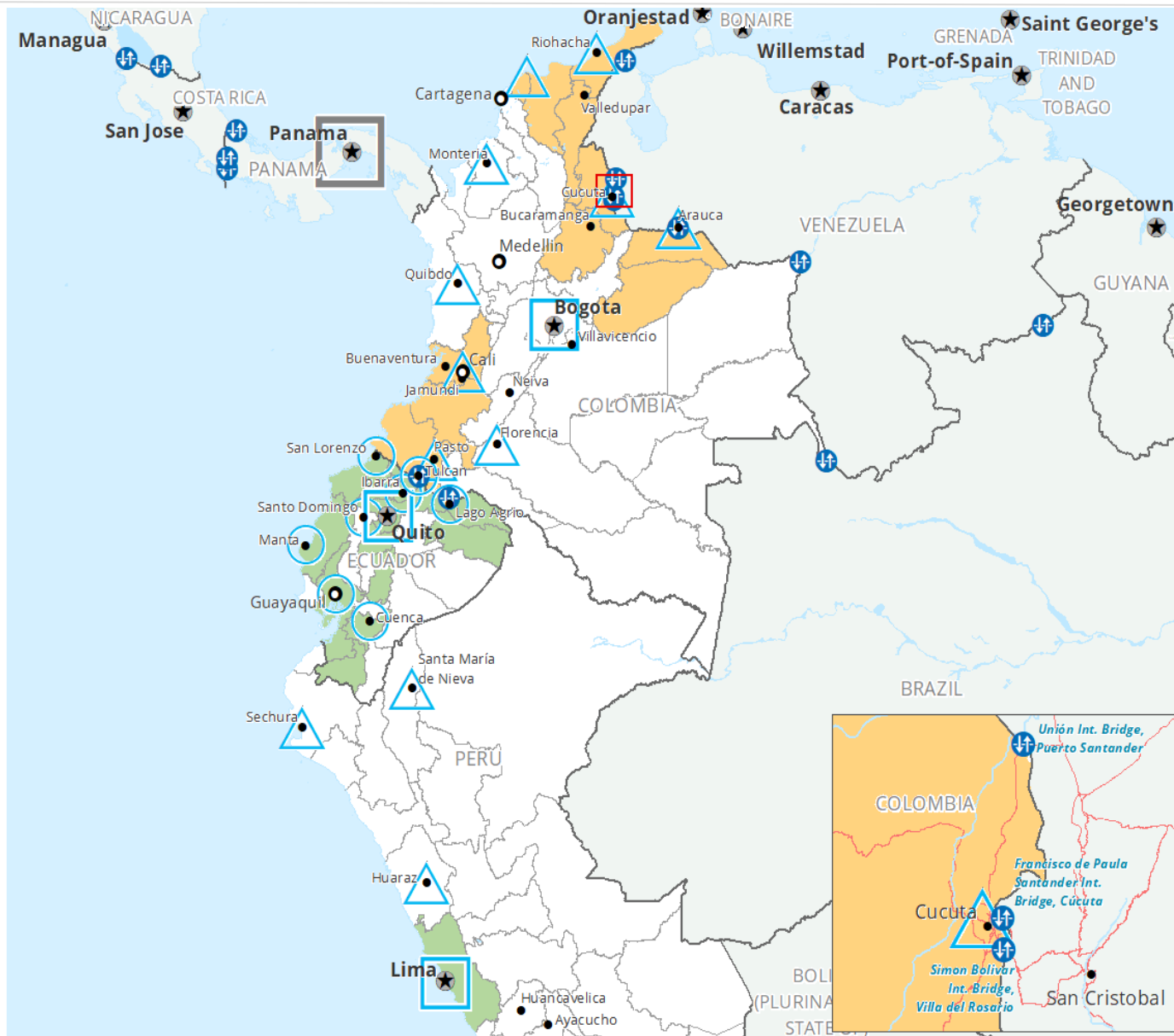

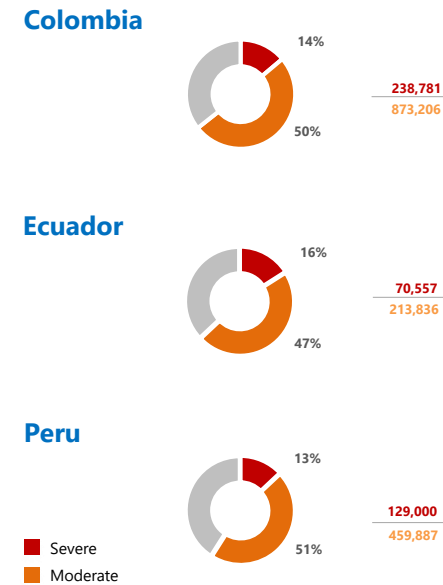

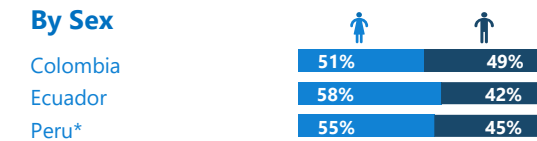
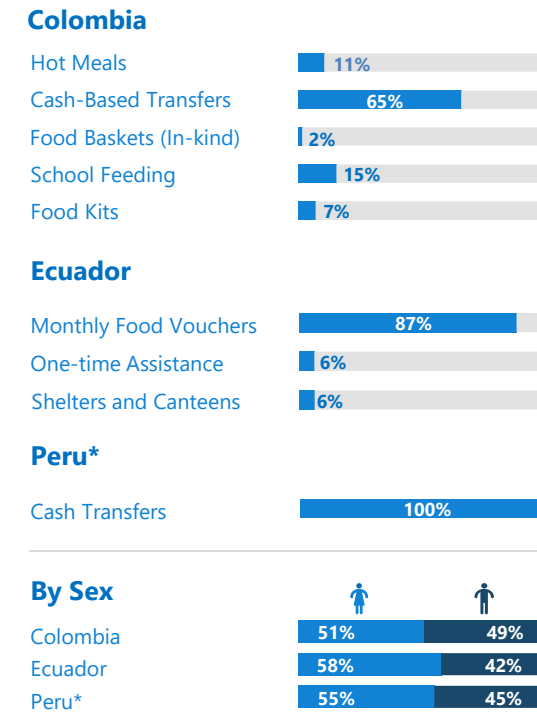

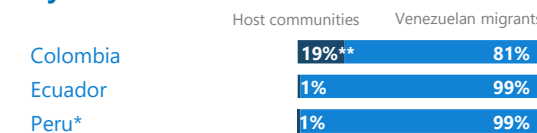

\*The Peru Country Office experienced a pipeline break that delayed field-level agreements with cooperating partners. Advanced financing has been secured and cash transfers resumed in August.

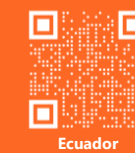
