

**OPERATIONAL UPDATES**

**BURKINA FASO**

In November, 744 passengers used the transport services of UNHAS, an unprecedented figure since the launch of the service. UNHAS operated 142 flights to 19 destinations, transported 10 tons of cargo and carried out its first medical and security evacuations.

**MALI**


Humanitarian needs in Mali keep increasing. WFP is aiming to assist 600,000 food insecure people during the pastoral lean season, including IDPs and vulnerable households. During the main lean season, assistance will be scaled to 1.2 million people.

**NIGER**

WFP is revising its budget to modify the 2022 emergency component in line with the growing emergency needs with an expected deterioration of the food and nutrition security, aiming at reaching up to an estimated 1.6 million beneficiaries under the emergency response component.




