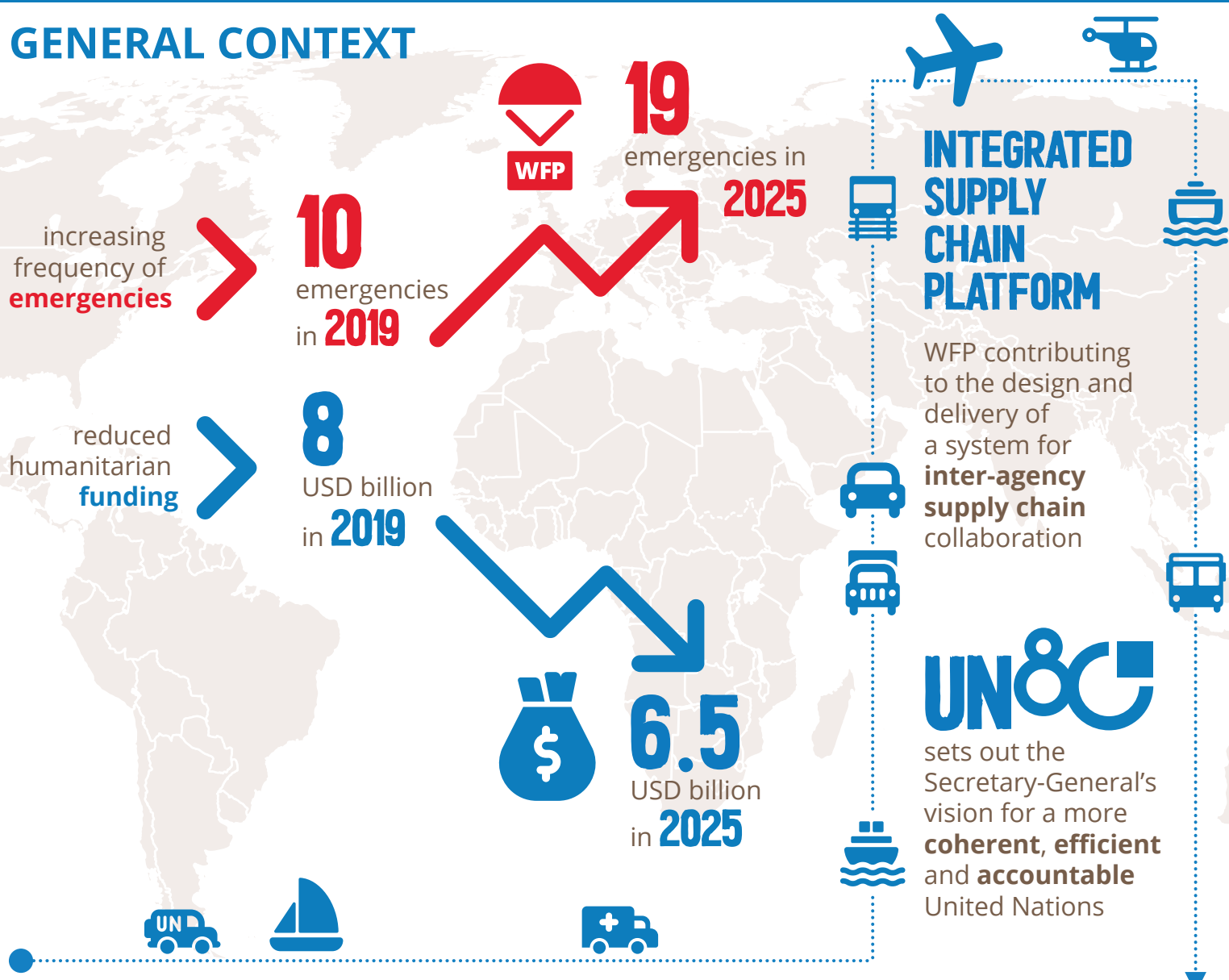

WFP affirmed as a preferred partner for the provision of supply chain services to the humanitarian community

NATIONAL SYSTEMS STRENGTHENING AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE LOCAL AND REGIONAL FOOD PROCUREMENT POLICY



Technical assistance, new technologies and support for infrastructure contributed to national systems strengthening and market development



Proportion of local and regional food procurement remained stable; expenditure on local procurement increased by 103%

'PARTNER OF CHOICE' FOR THE HUMANITARIAN COMMUNITY



Valued and trusted by partners for operational delivery, service provision and increasingly for global leadership



WFP diversified the type, nature and composition of its partnerships contributing to supply chain efficiency and national systems strengthening



Opportunity to expand joint service provision in the context of current and future UN reforms



Expansion of advance finance mechanisms has enabled more proactive planning; lower prices and faster procurement



Factors enhancing efficiency: economies of scale, longer-term presence in a country, national systems capacity



Factors hindering efficiency: access challenges, transferring in-kind donations

Ongoing efforts to integrate environmental sustainability considerations and measure the environmental footprint of supply chain operations



Working towards gender balance in staffing and making opportunities for women suppliers, but gaps remain
