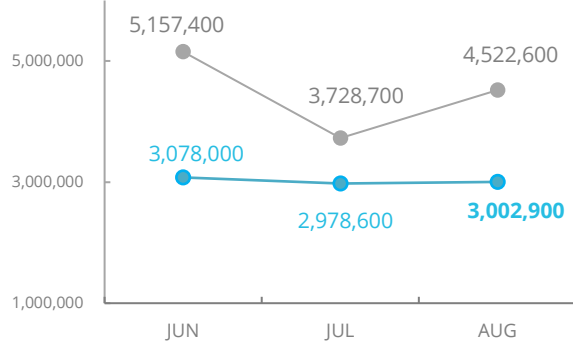

OPERATIONAL UPDATES

BURKINA FASO

In Tin-Akoff, 2,162 IDPs received 18mt of food and 2mt of specialized nutritious food aimed at preventing acute malnutrition in pregnant and lactating women and girls (PLW/Gs) and children aged 6-23 months.

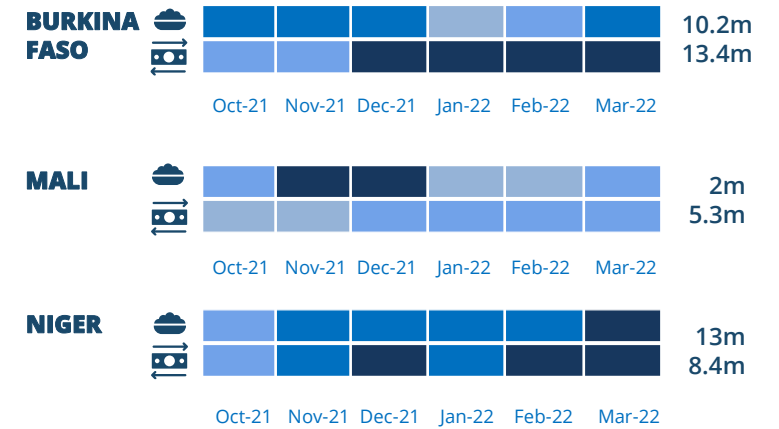
MALI

Following a spike in prices of some staple commodities in June 2021, a customized mVAM assessment was conducted in August to assess the impact and understand the drivers of the sudden increase in prices.

NIGER

WFP is supporting sensitization and preventives measures through implementing partners following announcement of Cholera outbreak in the country.

EXPECTED PIPELINE BREAKS (6-month shortfalls- US\$)



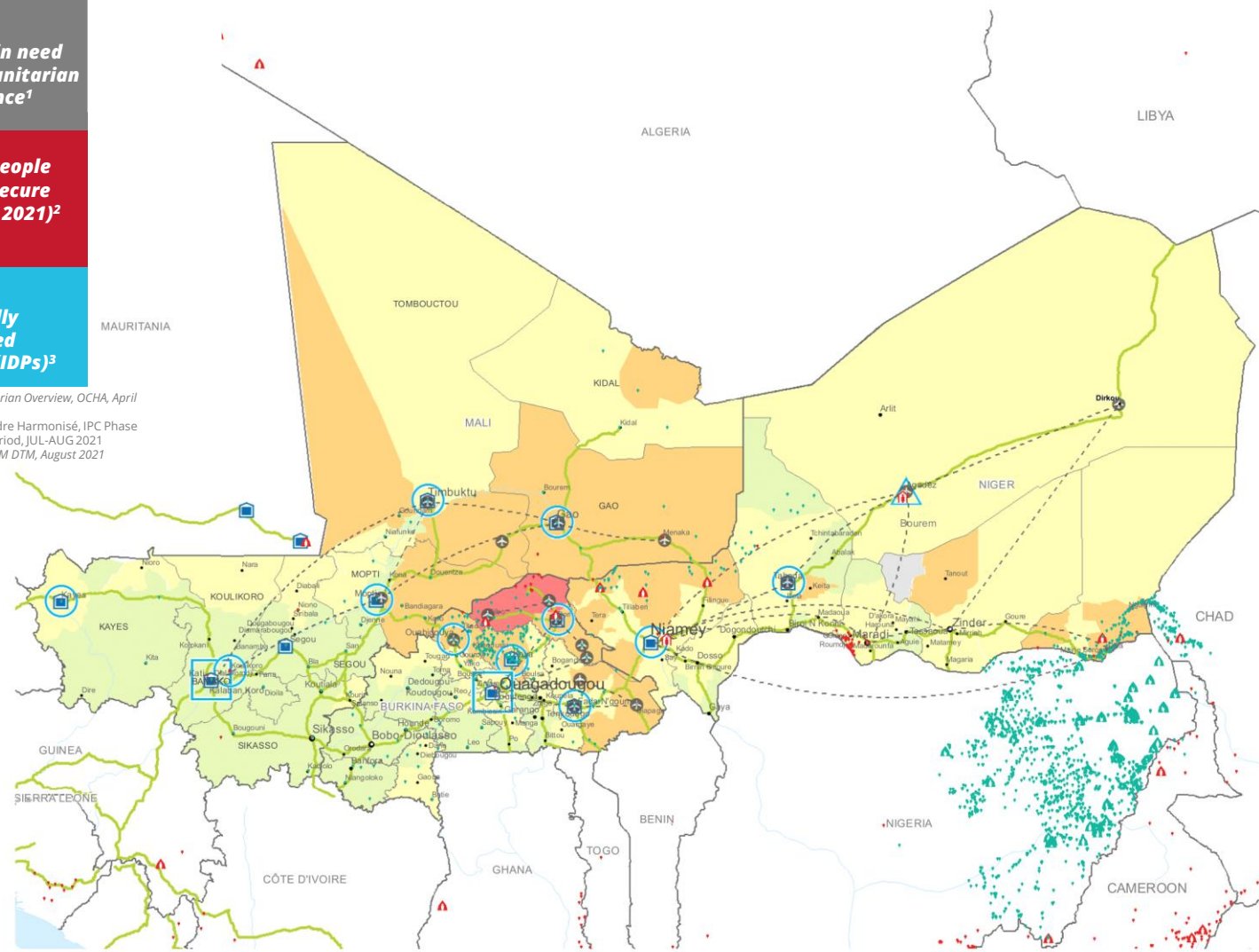

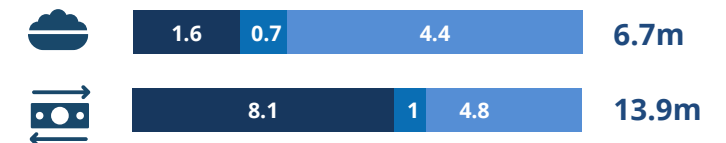
