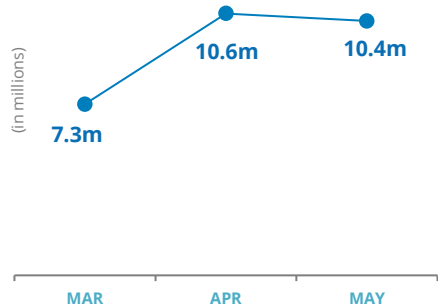

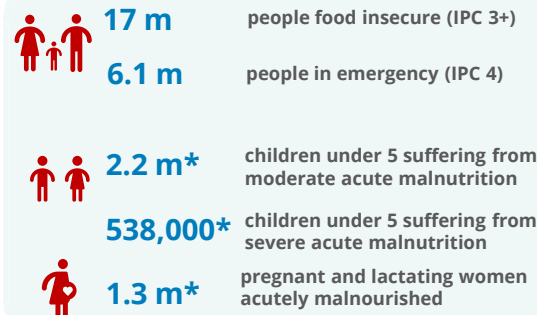

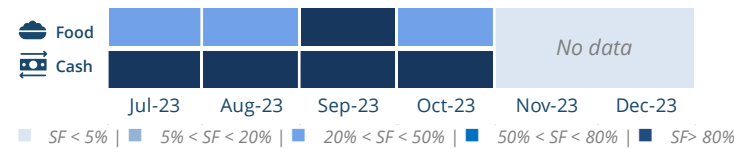


AVERAGE MONTHLY FUNDING REQUIREMENTS

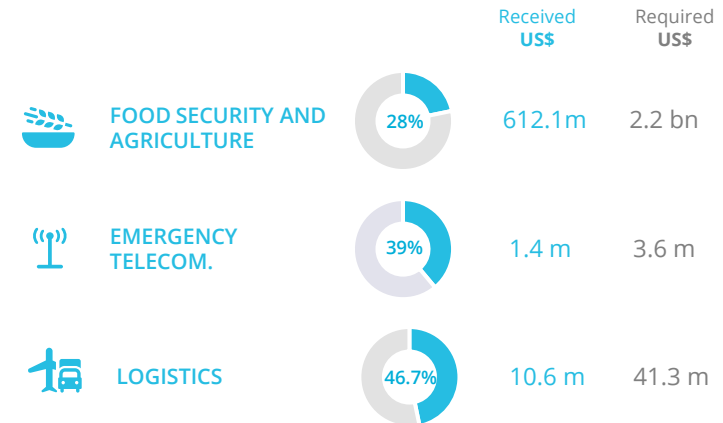

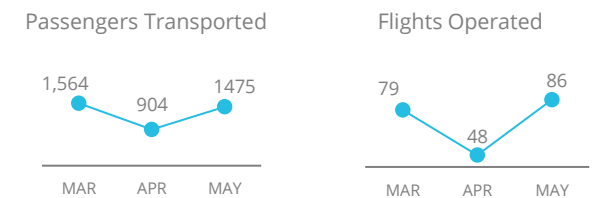
EXPECTED SHORTFALLS (SF)



WFP-LED AND CO-LED CLUSTERS



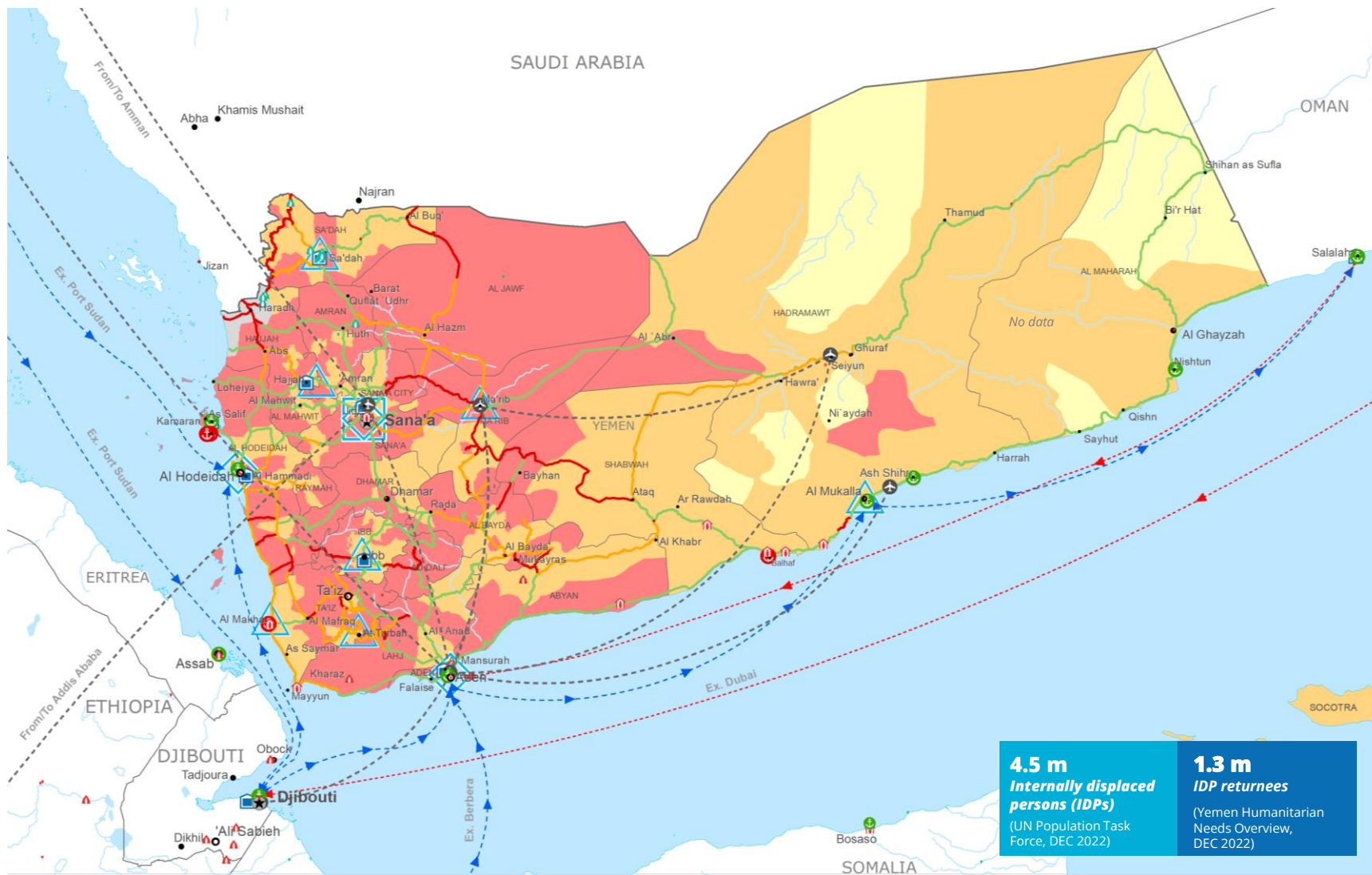
